## Students

\* As ease of reference, please note that Parents / Guardians of Lodge Group of Schools shall generally be classified as parents. Consent from parents will be obtained prior to administering any RTK(Ag) saliva test on our school premises. In the event that parents do not give consent for the school to administer the RTK(Ag) saliva test when required as below, the school will request the parents to bring their child home immediately to conduct the test at home.

\* In the event of any situation(s) that may arise which is/are not mentioned here, our school will handle it on a case to case basis.

<b>Tested Positive</b>	While the student is already in our School premises	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ Immediate arrangement will be made with the parents to bring the student(s) home</li> <li>➤ The said student will be placed at the quarantine room while waiting for the parents.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ Quarantine period of 7 days (Boosted / Fully Vaccinated).</li> <li>➤ Quarantine period of 10 days (Partially / Unvaccinated).</li> <li>➤ Classmates seated directly in front, behind, on the left &amp; the right side (considered as Close Contacts) of the said student who tested positive will undergo RTK(Ag) saliva test. (See procedure for Close Contact).</li> </ul>
	While the student is still at Home	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ Inform the Principal / Deputy Principal / Class Teacher immediately</li> <li>➤ The student concerned must not come to school</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ The rest of the classmates will continue with physical learning in school as per normal. However, parents are requested to monitor their health condition, for the next 5/7 days, depending on the vaccination status.</li> <li>➤ If the parents decide not to send their child to school, they must write in to inform the school of their decision.</li> <li>➤ The school will try its best to provide live streaming/recorded lessons.</li> <li>➤ The Principal will send an email to all of the parents in their entity to inform them of the positive case detected.</li> </ul>

<b>Close Contact /Feeling Unwell</b>	While the student is already in School premises	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ The student concerned will undergo RTK(Ag) saliva test.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ If the test result is positive, the student concerned will be placed in the quarantine room. Arrangements will be made for the parents / guardians to bring the student concerned home. He / she will undergo a quarantine period of 7/10 days as above.</li> <li>➤ If the test result is negative, the student concerned will be allowed to continue until the school ends for the day. He / she will revert to online learning from home for the next 5 / 7 days depending on the vaccination status. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• For fully vaccinated students, RTK(Ag) saliva test must be conducted on 3<sup>rd</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> day. If the test result on the 5<sup>th</sup> day is negative, he / she can come back for physical learning on the 6<sup>th</sup> day.</li> <li>• For partially / unvaccinated students, RTK(Ag) saliva test must be conducted on 3<sup>rd</sup>, 5<sup>th</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup> day. If the test result on the 7<sup>th</sup> day is negative, the student can come back for physical learning on the 8<sup>th</sup> day.</li> </ul> </li> <li>➤ The rest of their classmates will continue with physical learning in school as per normal.</li> <li>➤ If the parents decide not to send their child to school, they must write in to inform the school of their decision.</li> <li>➤ The school will try its best to provide live streaming/recorded lessons.</li> </ul>
