Dear Parents / Guardians,

Hope everybody is keeping healthy. Please take note of the following:

## **Students' Academic Awards effective 2022**

Starting from 2022, the current Top 3 and Progressive Class Position awards will be replaced by The Chairman's Academic Awards and The Director's Lister while the current Best Subject awards will be replaced by The Principal's Lister. This decision was derived after rounds of discussions and consultation with our Principals and Deputy Principals.

We are taking a major leap by moving away from Norm-Referenced and moving toward Criterion-Referenced awards. Lodge Group of Schools is the first to adopt this practice of recognizing our students.

Our primary objective is to have more students striving towards excellence based on targets set by our schools, without competing among their peers. This will also generate more encouragement among peers and more students will be able to receive awards when they achieve the targets set.

## **PICKids Programme 2<sup>nd</sup> dose COVID-19 vaccination for children aged 5 to 11 years old**

2<sup>nd</sup> dose Pfizer for \*International Primary students will be on 9 May at Normah Medical Specialist Centre.

\*Kindergarten and \*National Primary is scheduled to have the same on 11 May at Lodge National Secondary school hall.

\*Parents will receive more information from their respective class teachers when the date approaches.

Students who had opted for SinoVac for their 1<sup>st</sup> dose will proceed to Normah Medical Specialist Centre for their 2<sup>nd</sup> dose based on arrangements between Normah and the parents concerned.

## **Mid-year Exams 2022**

Above exams will commence from 20 to 30 May **except** for the following:

Kindergarten	: Assessment
Primary 1 - 3	: Assessment
Form 5	: 19 to 29 April
Yr 12	: 20 to 27 June

These exams will be conducted via **physical mode in our schools**. Detailed timetables will be informed by the individual entity. Students who miss the examination due to positive COVID-19 case, close contacts (**symptomatic**) or feeling unwell must submit medical certificate / supporting documents of the positive test results to their class teacher / Principal. They will sit for their examination from 13 to 17 June, **physically in the school**.

Students who are absent without valid reasons will be recorded as absent in LIS (Lodge Information System).

## **Teachers' Day 2022**

The above occasion will be observed on 17 May at Lodge Group of Schools. On this date, our students are permitted to put on their own attire to school. Be reminded that their attire to school must be decent and appropriate. Please note that as we are entering 'transition to endemic' phase, there will be strictly no individual / combined class parties. There will be speeches from the Director, Principals and recordings of students' performances and their appreciation messages for our teachers. This will be telecast to our students in their own classrooms at a designated time.

## *THE Chairman's Academic Award*

### **Eligibility:**

1. Having an Average Grade of at least **90% and no grade lower than 85% in all subjects.**
2. Examinations/Assessment concerned:
  - Average of the mid-year and year end Examinations for National Primary 1 - 6, National Secondary Form 1 - 4, International School Year 2 - 10;
  - Average of mid-year and Mock Examination for National Secondary Form 5, International School Year 11 & 12;
  - Mock Examination only for International School Year 13;
  - Average of mid-year and year end Progressive Assessment for Kindy A - Kindy C;
  - Full Attendance of mid-year and year end School Examination

**The Award** shall be a specially designed certificate signed by the Chairman and cash of RM40.00.

**However**, if a student achieves an overall average mark of 95% for all subjects taken from the examinations mentioned above, with no subject below 90% for both examinations, he/she shall be awarded a specially designed certificate, signed by the Chairman and cash of RM300.00.

## *THE Director's Lister*

### **Eligibility:**

1. Having an Average Grade of at least **85 % and no grade lower than 80% in all subjects.**
2. Examinations/Assessment concerned:
  - Average of the mid-year and year end Examinations for National Primary 1 - 6, National Secondary Form 1 - 4, International School Year 2 - 10;
  - Average of mid-year and Mock Examination for National Secondary Form 5, International School Year 11 & 12;
  - Mock Examination only for International School Year 13;
  - Average of mid-year and year end Progressive Assessment for Kindy A - Kindy C;
  - Full Attendance of mid-year and year end of Year School Examination.

**The Award** shall be a specially designed certificate, signed by the Director and cash of RM30.00.

## *THE Principal's Lister*

### **Eligibility:**

1. Having an Average Grade of at least **85% and no grade lower than 80% in the subject.**
2. Examinations/Assessment concerned:
  - Average of the mid-year and year end Examinations for National Primary 1- 6, National Secondary Form 1 - 4, International School Year 2 - 10;
  - Average of mid-year and Mock Examination for National Secondary Form 5, International School Year 11 & 12;
  - Mock Examination only for International School Year 13;
  - Average of mid-year and year end Progressive Assessment for Kindy A - Kindy C;
  - Full Attendance of mid-year and year end School Examination.

**The Award** shall be a specially designed certificate, signed by the Principal and cash of RM15.00 for each subject.
