Dear Parents / Guardians,

Please take note of the following updates:

1. Current Hot Weather & Haze Conditions

Sarawak is currently experiencing extremely hot humid weather coupled with haze conditions. Our schools are concerned that such weather conditions may lead to heat wave which will inadvertently pose serious health issues.

Following are several measures which we have administered:

- 1.1 All of our Physical Education (PE) lessons will be conducted indoors until weather conditions improve or until 28 August 2026, whichever comes first;
- 1.2 Air conditioning in our classrooms and special rooms will be switched on from the first lessons until lessons conclude for the day;
- 1.3 School prefects and class monitors are exempted from wearing blazers / vests;
- 1.4 Students have been advised and encouraged to consume adequate drinking water daily;
- 1.5 All uniform bodies, clubs and societies activities will be conducted indoors and with less strenuous activities;
- 1.6 Students with medical health issues have been advised to wear face mask to school or to seek medical attention or to stay at home, when necessary;
- 1.7 Lodge will monitor the Air Pollution Index (API) closely and seek advice from the Education and Medical Departments on the necessary and appropriate actions required from time to time.

- 3.2 Dangerous items, for example, iron rods, brass knuckles, lighters, matches, knives, metal chains and such.
- 3.3 Children in possession of any dangerous / sharp items will have the items confiscated and our school will inform their parents immediately.

Term break 2026 for Lodge Group of Schools (including After School Care) will be from 29 August until 6 September. Lessons will resume on 7 September.

We would like to take this opportunity to wish everyone Happy Merdeka Day! (31 August).

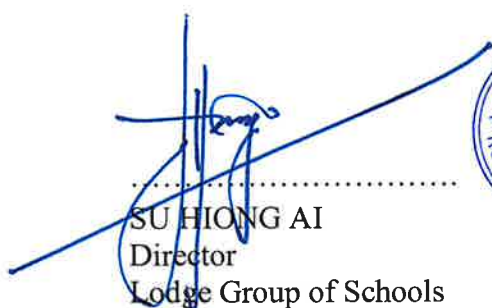
